in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars to him the said Philip
Baker in hand paid by the said William Smith and August Shearer the re-
ceipt whereof the said Philip doth hereby acknowledge, have granted, bar-
gained, sold, conveyed ^{and by their heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, and assigns} and confirmed, unto them the said William
Smith and August Shearer and to their heirs and assigns forever Four
certain tracts of land estimated to contain each One thousand acres or
the same more or less, being lots numbered thirty seven & thirty eight of the
third quarter of the tenth Township and fourth Range and lots num-
bered four and six of the fourth quarter tenth Township and fifth Range
of the tract appropriated for satisfying warrants for Military services
being and being in the County of Columbiana and State of Ohio which under and
by virtue of four Patents issued by the President of the United States
bearing date the fourth day of February one thousand eight hundred
and twenty was Patented Paul Foxson, who by deed of conveyance bearing
