

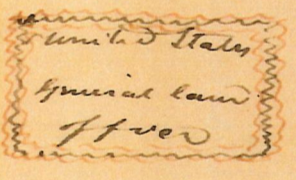

James Madison, President of the United States of America To all to whom these presents shall come Greetings

Know ye that David Miller of Tuscarawas County Ohio having deposited in the General Land office a certificate of the Register of the land office at Zanesville whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the Southeast quarter of Section twenty two of Township nine in range five of the unappropriated lands in the Military District of the States directed to be sold at Zanesville by the Act of Congress entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory Northwest of the Ohio and above the Mouth of a West Virginia river" &c. of the amendments of the same there is granted by the United States unto the said David Miller the 1/4 lot or Section of land above described. To have and to hold the said quarter lot or Section of land with the appurtenances unto the said David Miller his heirs and assigns forever.



In testimony whereof I have caused this Letter to be made public Law the seal of the General Land office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourth and of the independence of the United States of America the thirty ninth
