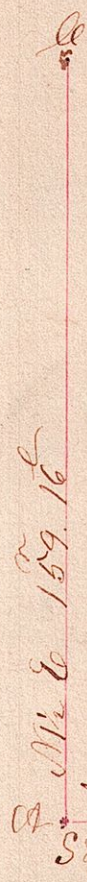

Put brass button under the stone at A
Also the N. E. corner of sec. one Sp 8 of R 7.

At the planting of the stone at B there were present L. D. Newton & father Robinson John Belle Daniel Spring John Steel & Daniel Baughman

the stone at A sand stone
Bottom ⁱⁿ 10 by 12 } length 2 1/2 in
Top ⁱⁿ 7 " 10 }

A B the corner stone at B about the same size.

Put pieces of window glass in the bottoms of the holes in which the corner stones were planted
At A one piece was in the shape of a bow very much hollowed on the bottom

Planted the above described corners on the 15th day of June A D 1860. — I certify the above to be a correct account of the planting
