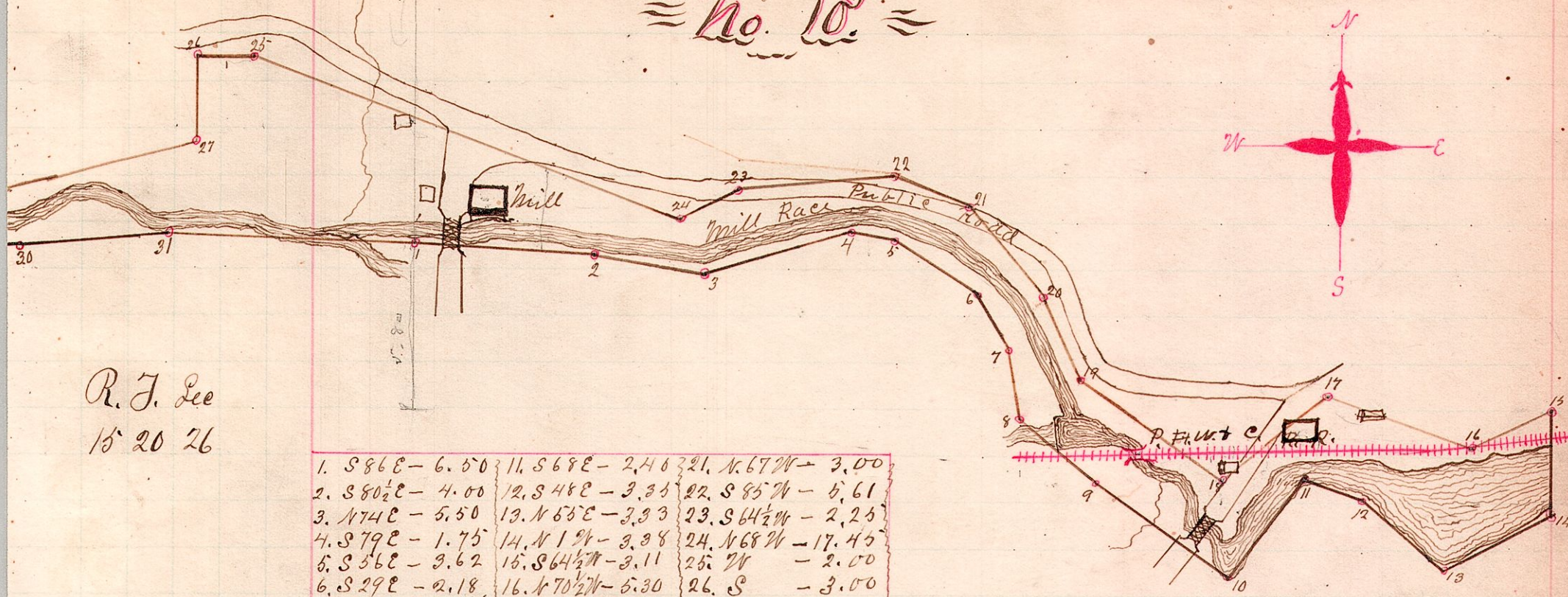

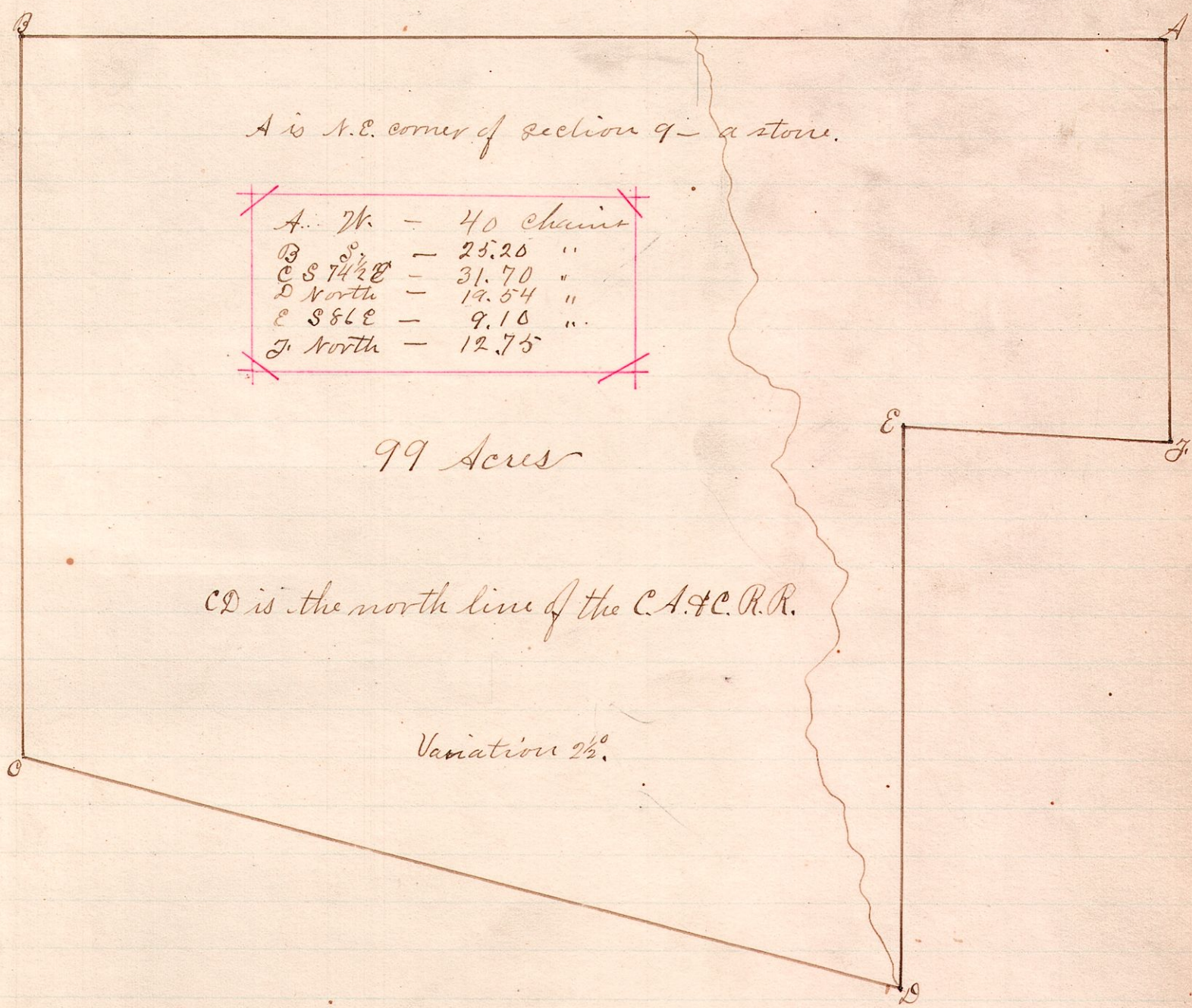
Station 1 is 21.87 chains north of a stone at the south west corner of the south east quarter of Section 26.
