

Notice of Legal Survey.

To William H. Patterson, Paul Daniels, Harper Daniels, Mary Gost and Agnes Ledbetter:

You are hereby notified that a survey will be made and testimony taken by the County Surveyor of Holmes County, Ohio, on the 31st day of March, 1891, between the hours of 10 A.M. and 6 P.M. and to continue from time to time at the request of said County Surveyor, until the lines, boundaries, and corners of the following described tract of land, now owned and held by Nicholas Hanni and situated in Richland township, Holmes County, Ohio, can be established:

The same being the North-west quarter of the South-west quarter of Section 6 Township 8 Range 8. Interested parties are hereby notified to give said Surveyor the names of witnesses they wish subpoenaed and to be present at said survey.

Signed this 23d day of February 1891.
"Nicholas Hanni."

A copy of the above notice was served on each of the ~~above~~ parties named therein on the 23d day of February 1891, by Nicholas Hanni.

I proceeded to survey said tract of land as described in the above notice on the day set therein, and make the following return of the same:

The Southwest, Southeast, and Northeast corners being undisputed and marked by stones, we proceeded to reestablish the North-west corner which was lost. No witnesses were produced. William Miller & - - - - - were sworn and acted as chain carriers. After chaining $DA = CB$ and measuring $DA = CB$, and $AB = DC$, we planted a stone corner at A and took new witnesses at the corners A, B & C, as the original witnesses were gone.
