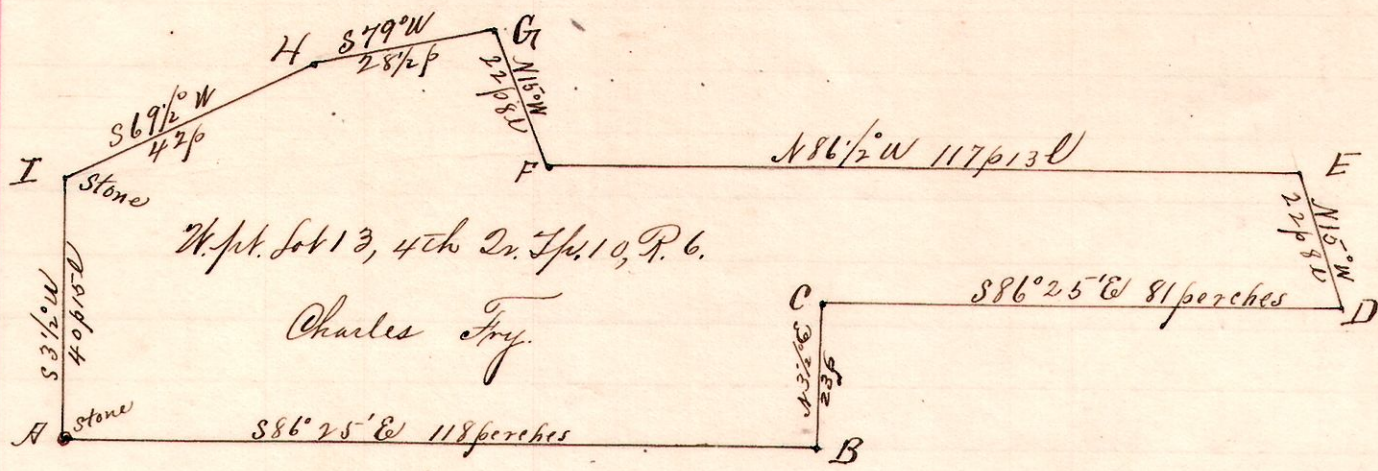

- "I", a stone on the west line of said lot $S 3 1/2^{\circ} W$ 40 p 15 U to A.

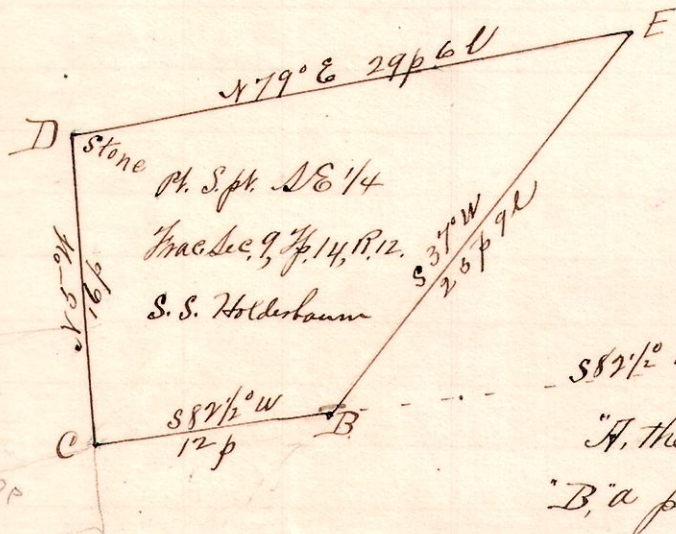
