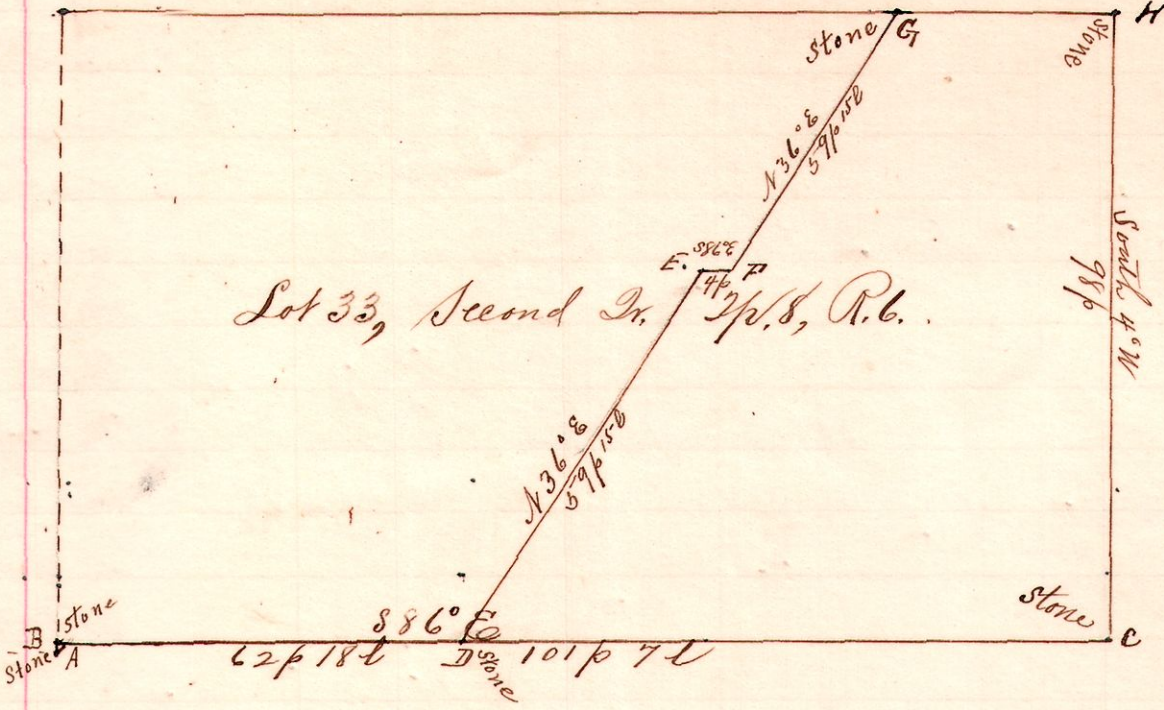

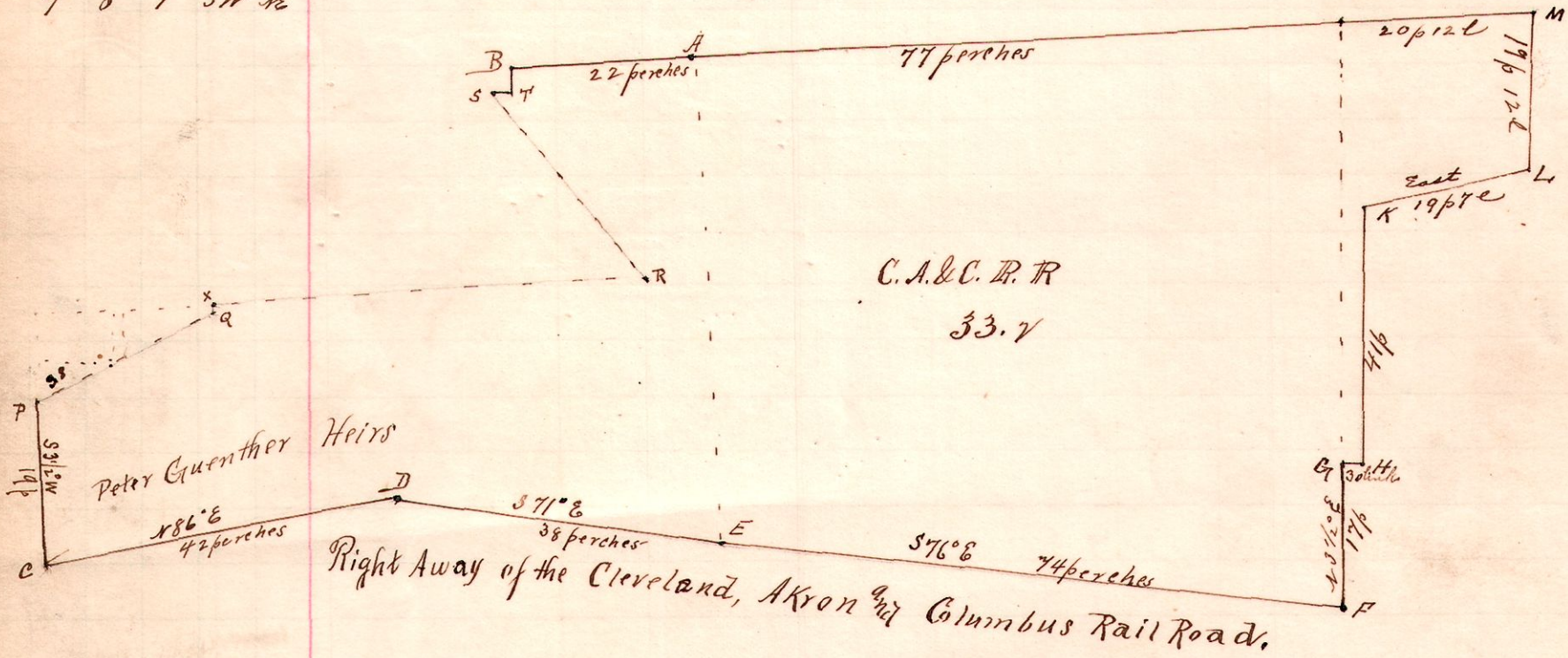
Notes

"B" the southwest corner of said quarter township and of Lot 33 of said Tr 7p being disputed, we established a stone corner from said notes. Found stone corner at C & G. Established " " " D & H.

"PQRSTB" formed the southeast boundary on flat of territory proposed to be incorporated as Manning in 1892.
"PQRSTB AM L K HGFEDCP" the additional part to said flat of Manning to be incorporated as the town of Glenmont.
'P' is the southwest corner of original Lot 38 as plotted in the original Survey of the town of Napoleon, afterwards known as Black creek, then Manning, then Pictoria, now to be called Glenmont.
