Survey made for J.C. & W. Duncan and the Village of Killbuck Ohio, for the purpose of Extending Main Street north to Public Road at Railroad Bridge.

Commenced at ^{S.W.} corner Lot 165 marked "A" and extended north in a straight line with Main St. as located in Block between McKinley Street on South and Duncan St. on North. Pt. A found original stake of lot in good condition. run N 12° 30' E 520 ft. to "B" and set Iron Post.

Also extended Roosevelt Street 33' wide East 248 1/2' to Railroad Street at set Iron posts at corners of same.

Also extended Duncan Street 40' wide from Main St. Public Road as shown on plat.

These streets having been dedicated to the Village of Killbuck by J.C. & W. Duncan and are situate on lot #7 in said village.
