

Petition for Annexation

PETITION TO ANNEX PART OF CLARK TWP. TO BALTIC VILLAGE

Mr. Dennis Getz as agent for Baltic Village filed the following petition and presented an accurate map of the same. Both are on file in the Auditor's Office.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS OF HOLMES COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO
The undersigned, being a majority of the adult freeholders residing on the following described territory, situated in the County of Holmes and adjacent to the Village of Baltic, to-wit:

Situated in the Township of Clark, County of Holmes and State of Ohio. Being a part of the southwest quarter of Section Twenty five (25), Township Eight (8), Range Four (4) and being more fully described as follows: Beginning at a stone monument at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of said Section Twenty-five (25); thence with the south line thereof North 86° 30' West, 2386.2 Feet to the southwest corner of 65.05 acre tract conveyed to Dennis E. and J. Nadine Getz by deed recorded in Volume 115, Page 27 of the Holmes County Deed Records, said corner being South 86° 30' East, 582.9 Feet from a stone monument at the southwest corner of the southwest quarter of said Section Twenty-five (25); thence North 4° 06' East, 1040.6 feet to a post at the northwest corner of said 65.05 acre tract; thence with the north line thereof South 86° 50' East, 958.1 feet; thence North 8° 00' East, 30.0 feet; thence South 86° 50' East, 680.0 feet to a point in State Route No. 557; thence leaving said State Route No. 557 South 89° 57' East, 540.6 feet to the southwest corner of a 1.0 acre tract conveyed to the Wheeling and Lake Erie Railway Company by deed recorded in Volume 99, Page 133 of the Holmes County Deed Records; thence with the south line thereof South 70° 05' East, 200.0 feet to a point of the east line of the southwest quarter of said Section Twenty-five (25); thence with the east line thereof South 3° 19' West, 1056.0 feet to the place of beginning, containing 58.36 acres more or less.
