Plan and description of the town of Martinsburg

The following plan or plan of the town of Martinsburg shows
what part or parts of said town are intended for sale and what parts
are intended for streets and alleys to wit those parts or portions
numbered from 1 to 26 and five lots three perches in width and
nine perches back. The parts or portions of said town to be known
by the appellation of streets are those marked "Jackson Street"
three perches in width and bearing N. 30.° E. or S. 30.° W. "Coul-
son Street" of the same width as Jackson and bearing S. 60.° E.
or N. 60.° W. and crossing said Jackson Street at right angles "Mill
Street" of the same width or breadth as Jackson and parallel thereto
and also "Crawford Street" of the same breadth or width as Jackson
Street and parallel thereto. There is also an alley one perch wide in
the rear of and adjoining to lots 1 to 19. Also one other
alley parallel to and adjoining lots 9 & 10. Also one of the same
width in the rear of and adjoining lots 23 & 24. Also
one other alley of the same width in the rear of lots 18 to 18
or rather between lots 11 to 17 & lots 19 to 26 the relative
situation of all of which are as marked on the plan below
