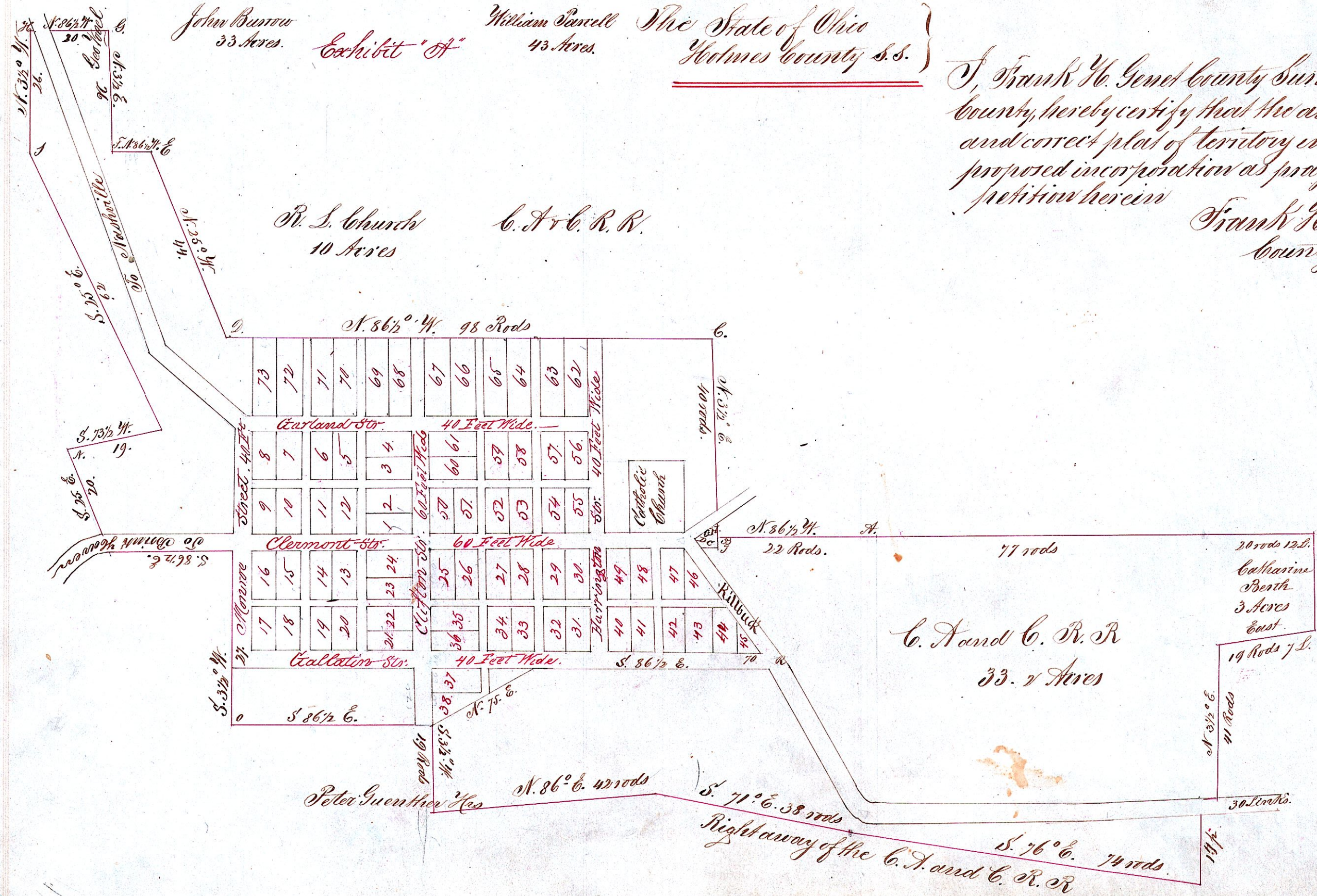

In the Matter of the Incorporation of the Village of Glenmont Holmes County Ohio

Petition.

We the undersigned resident electors of the Town of Victoria in said County of Holmes desiring a more effective government of our Village hereby request you as such county commissioners in accordance with the Law in such cases to cause said town to be incorporated as a Village under and by the name of Glenmont and to embrace and include the following territory bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a post 32 Rods west of the South east corner of the North West Quarter of Section 1. Township 8. Range 9 in said County of Holmes, thence North 40 Rods to a post thence West 98 Rods to a post. thence North 27 1/2 degrees West 44 Rods to a post. thence West 10 Rods to a post thence North 26 rods to a post thence West 20 rods to the West line of said Quarter, thence South on said line 26 rods to a post, thence South 25 Degrees East 62 rods to a post, thence South 73 1/2 degrees West 19 Rods to a post thence South 25 degrees East 20 rods to the South line of Glenmont Street thence East along the South line of Glenmont Street 27 rods to the west line of Monroe Street thence South along the West line of Monroe Street 27 rods to a post, thence East 29 Rods to the East line of Clifton Street and the South West corner of Lot 38, thence South 19 Rods to the North line of the right of way to the Cleveland Akron and Columbus Railway Company, thence along the North line of said right of way in an easterly direction 134 rods, thence North 17 rods to the North side of the public road, thence East 1 rod and 5 links, thence North 44 Rods, thence East 19 rods and 7 links thence North 19 rods and 12 links to a post thence West 19 rods and 12 links to the place of beginning.

We also represent that the territory above described contains territory laid off in lots and recorded as deeds in the Records of said County and also adjacent territory thereto not laid off into lots and that the map and plat accompanying this petition and made a part hereof marked "A" is an accurate map of said territory and that the number of inhabitants residing on said Territory is supposed to be two hundred and twenty.

We further desire that John S. Zimmerman and George Zollers act as Agents for the undersigned petitioners herein.

Wherefore we ask that said town may be incorporated as herein set forth as the Village of Glenmont

Transcript of the proceedings had before the Commissioners of Holmes County Ohio for the incorporation of the Village of Glenmont

Auditors Office Holmes County Ohio
Millersburg O. March the 2^d 1896.

In the Matter of the Incorporation
of the Village of Glenmont. }

On this 2^d day of March 1896 the Board of Commissioners of the County of Holmes Ohio being in regular Session a petition was presented to said board of Commissioners praying for the incorporation of the Town of Victoria in said Holmes County as the incorporated Village of Glenmont. Said petition is hereby ordered to be filed in the Auditors Office for the inspection of all persons interested, which is accordingly done under the Signature of said County Auditor this 2^d day of March 1896. Thereupon this board of Commissioners hereby fixes the 7th day of May 1896 at 10 o'clock a.m. as the time, and the Commissioners Office in the Court House of said Holmes County Ohio as the place for hearing said petition and the Agents named in said petition being present they are hereby ordered and directed to cause a Notice containing the substance of the said petition together with the time and place where the same will be heard to be published in some newspaper printed and of general circulation in said Holmes County for the period of six consecutive Weeks and cause a copy of the notice to be posted in a conspicuous place within the limits of said proposed corporation at least six Weeks prior to the 7th day of May 1896 the time fixed for hearing the petition by this board to which time the further consideration of this matter is adjourned and the Auditor is hereby directed to enter all the orders herein made on the Journal.

Entry

In the Matter of the Incorporation of the Village of Glenmont.

In pursuance to the former order of this board made the 2^d day of March 1896 the board all members being present to wit David Helmuth, Geo. W. Spencer and W. R. Donald met this 7th day of May 1896 at 10 o'clock A.M. in the Office of the board of Commissioners in the Court House of said County to publically hear and determine the petition filed herein in this Matter and this board of Commissioners find that the Agents named in said petition John F. Zimmerman

and George Zellers caused a Notice of incorporation containing the substance of said petition and the time and place of the hearing of said petition to be published in the Millerburg Sentinel a Newspaper printed and of general circulation in said County of Holmes for the period of six consecutive weeks beginning on the 5th day of March 1896 and said board further finds that said ^{Agents caused a copy of said} notice of incorporation containing the substance of the petition together with the time and place of hearing the same to be posted at the Post Office at Victoria the same being a conspicuous place within the limits of said proposed incorporation on the 7th day of March 1896 the same being six weeks prior to this 7th day of May 1896 the time fixed for hearing said petition. The proofs of the publication of said notice of incorporation and the posting of a copy of the same within the limits of said proposed incorporation having been heretofore filed herein, and this Matter coming on to be heard on the petition, plans and affidavits and a remonstrance to said petition and the Agents named in said petition John F. Zimmerman and George Zellers together with their Attorney W. S. Yarnall were present as also was Joseph Borders and his Attorney W. Stillwell who opposed the prayer of the petition and upon consideration of said petition and the evidence this board of Commissioners find that the petition contains an accurate description of the territory embraced within the proposed incorporation and includes territory laid off into lots and recorded as Blocks are recorded and also territory adjacent thereto not laid off in ^{to} lots and that said petition further contains the supposed number of inhabitants of said territory to wit about 220 and that the petition asks that the territory described therein be incorporated as a Village by the name of Glenmont and that said petition names John F. Zimmerman and George Zellers as Agent of the Petitioners and this board further finds that said petition contains all the matters required that the statements contained in said petition are true that the name Glenmont is an appropriate name for said incorporation that the limits of said proposed incorporation are accurately described in said petition and are reasonable in extent and size that the plot accompanying said petition is accurate, that the persons whose names are subscribed to the petition with the exception of J. W. McLaughlin, J. C. Alexander and Samuel Gross are electors residing on the territory in the petition described and sought to be incorporated that notice of the hearing of the petition was given as required by Law in this Matter that the population of said territory in the petition described is more than two hundred and appears to this board of Commissioners right and proper that the prayer of said petition be granted, it is therefore ordered and directed by this board of Commissioners

That the territory in the petition described and outlined on the plot
 accompanying said petition be organized as a Village to be and to
 be known as the incorporated village of Glenmont in Holmes
 County State of Ohio and it is hereby ordered that all the orders and
 findings by this Board in this Matter be spread upon the Journal
 of this Board and the Auditor is hereby directed to make out a transcript
 of all the orders and proceedings of this Board and which shall together
 with the petition map and all other papers relating to this matter on
 file, be delivered to the Recorder of the County at the earliest time
 practicable.
