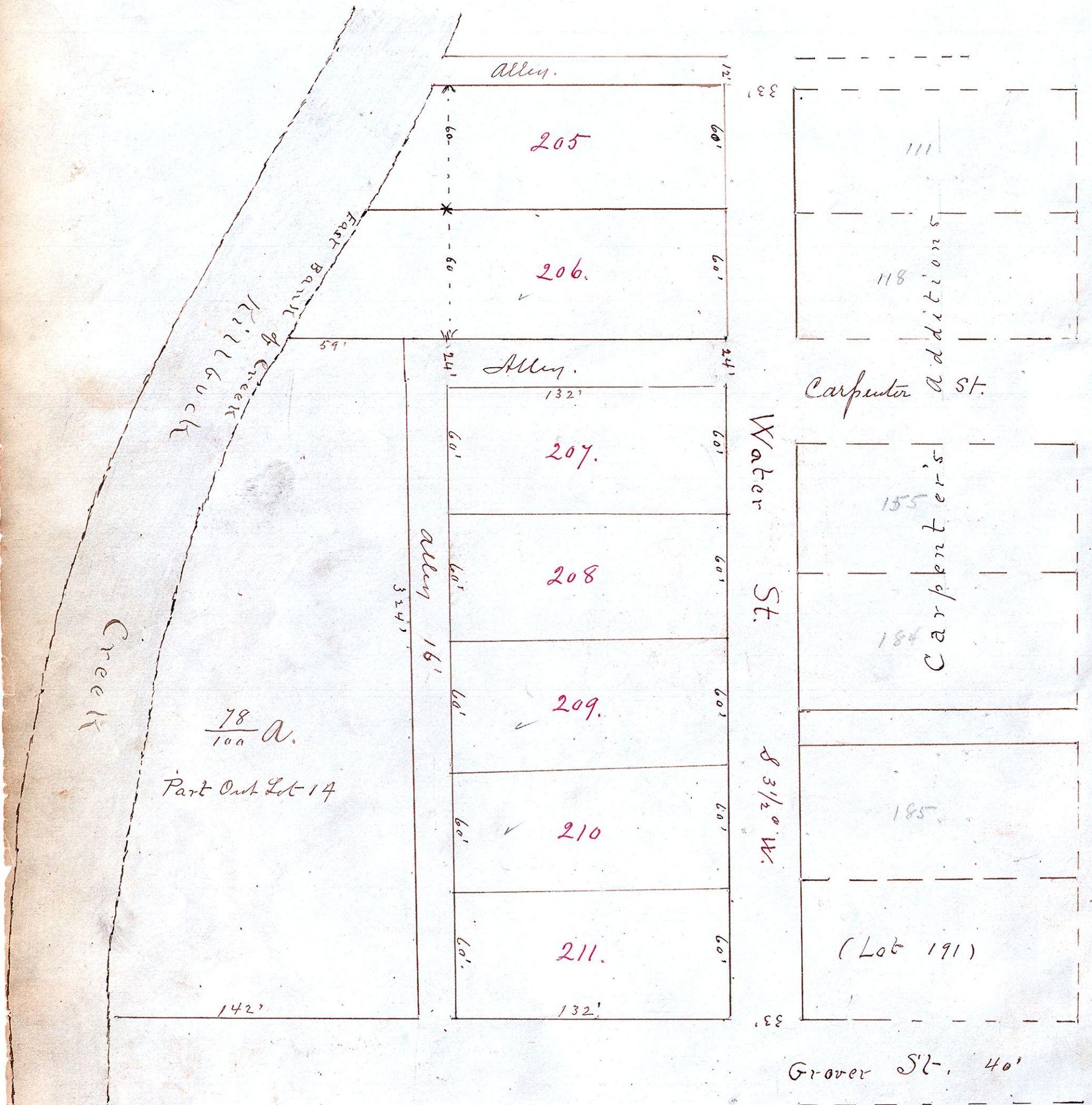


PLAT OF IN. MILLER'S ADDITION.
