

Description

This sub-division lies immediately east of the first sub-division in the same Quarter-Section.

"A" is a stone at the Northeast corner of this tract of land 18" west of the true corner which is in the west line of right-of-way of the Dresden Branch of the C.A. & C.R.R.

"B" is a stone at the South-east corner of this tract of land 9" west of the true corner.

One-half of the public road (20') is taken from this tract.

Streets and alleys to be of the width hereon shown for public use and convenience

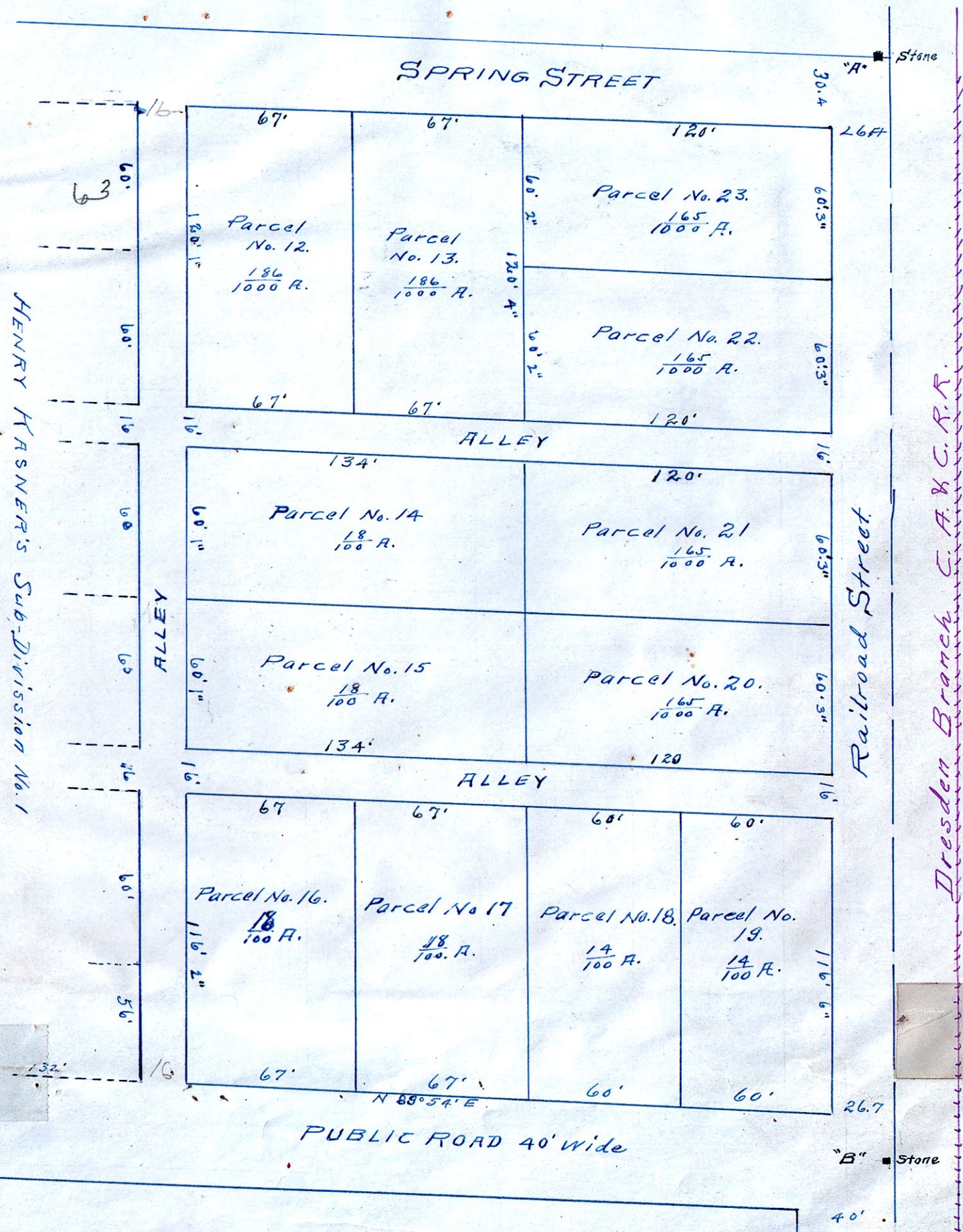
