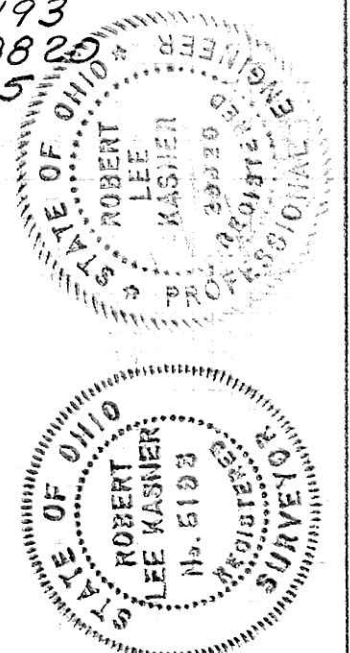

ORDER OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR ANNEXATION

The commissioners of the County of Holmes, State of Ohio, proceeding this 3rd day of June, 1985, to hear the petition of Harold A. Ezri to obtain the annexation of the territory described in his petition to the Village of Millersburg, and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition and being fully advised find that said petition contains all the matters required by law; that its statements are true; that the territory sought to be annexed is adjacent to the said Village of Millersburg and is not unreasonably large; that the petition contains a full description of said territory; that the map of said territory attached to the petition is accurate; that said petition is signed by a majority of the adult freeholders residing in the territory sought to be annexed; that the required legal notice of the petition has been given; and that the general good of the territory sought to be annexed will be served if the annexation petition is granted.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that the territory described in said petition may be annexed to the Village of Millersburg in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript signed by a majority of this board of all the orders and proceedings of this board relative to said petition and hearing thereon, together with said petition and map attached thereto, and all the papers on file relating to said matter be deposited at once with the Clerk of the Village of Millersburg.

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Commissioners of Holmes County, State of Ohio:

The undersigned, being the only adult freeholder owning the following described territory situated in the County of Holmes and adjacent to the Village of Millersburg, to wit:

Situated in the Township of Hardy, County of Holmes and State of Ohio being a part of the north part of the southeast quarter of Section 19 in Township 9, in Range 7 of the Virginia Military Lands subject to sale at Zanesville, Ohio, commencing at a stone at the northwest corner of said quarter; thence south 85 degrees.04 minutes east 518.4 feet to an iron post in the center of the public road; thence south 7 degrees east along the center of the road 493 feet to a point in the center of the road which said point marks the place of beginning of the land hereby conveyed and being the southwest corner of the lot now owned by Marjorie Troyer; thence north 83 degrees east along the south line of the lot of said Marjorie Troyer a distance of 213 feet to an iron post being the southeast corner of Marjorie Troyer's lot; thence south 7 degrees east 150 feet to an iron post; thence south 83 degrees west and being parallel with the south line of the Marjorie Troyer lot a distance of 213 feet to a point in the center of the public road; thence north 7 degrees west along the center of the public road to the place of beginning and being subject to the right of way of the State Highway. Containing .72 of an acre, more or less.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following described tract of land;

Being a part of the north part of the southeast quarter of section 19, township 9, range 7, commencing at a stake on the northwest corner of said quarter; thence south 85° 04' east, 518.4 feet to an iron post in the center of the public road; thence south 7° east along the center of said public road a distance of 643 feet being the southwest corner of a lot of land owned by E. N. and Anna Troyer and being the place of beginning of the lands to be hereby conveyed; thence north 83° east a distance of 213 feet being the southeast corner of the E. N. and Anna Troyer lot; thence north 7° west along the east line of the Troyer lot, a distance of 70 feet; thence south 83° west and being parallel with the said south line of the Troyer lot a distance of 213 feet to a point on the center of the public highway; thence south 7° east a distance of 70 feet to the place of beginning, estimated to contain 36/100 of acre of land, more or less. This conveying to the Grantee, Harold T. Blum the south seventy feet off of the said lot of land owned by said E. N. Troyer, and Anna Troyer, described in Deed Record Vol. 106, Page 394.

MILLER MINING PERMIT APPLICATION SIGNED

Miller Mining, Inc. has made public notice of intent to request this road permit. An opportunity for interested parties to present testimony was provided on June 3, 1985 and it is found, based on that testimony, that the interests of the public and the landowners will be protected. Therefore, this road permit is granted effective June 3, 1985 and shall remain in effect until coal mining operations are completed under the coal mining permit issued pursuant to this permit.

Pursuant to Sections 4153.11 and 1513.073 of the Ohio Revised Code, the applicant is granted a permit to conduct surface coal mining operations within the right-of-way and within 30 feet of the traveled portion of public road number 168. The actual variance request location is approximately 2000 feet east of the intersection of County Road 168 and State Route 515 for a distance of 1300 feet more or less.

A hearing was conducted at 10:30 a.m. Chairman Hershberger opened the hearing and recognized David Longfellow of Miller Mining, Inc. There were no other persons present to object to the permit. Mr. Hershberger then declared the hearing closed, whereupon the above permit was signed by all members of the Board.
